

DAY ONE

Arrive at Heathrow and transfer to accommodation at Windsor for two nights.

DAY TWO

Spend a relaxing day in Windsor.

DAY FIVE

Still on the Isle of Wight we visit Osborne House in the morning and Carisbrooke Castle in the afternoon.

DAY SIX

Back on the mainland we explore more beautiful thatched villages in Dorset where we spend the night.

DAY SEVEN

We will visit some beautiful thatched villages in the Dorset Countryside on the way to our home for the next week in Bodmin, Cornwall.

DAY EIGHT

The Cornish coast is magnificent. This morning we head for Megavissey and then on to Portloe, Veryan and St Mawes.

DAY NINE

An early start this morning as we visit St Ives, the ancient Celtic village of Chysauster and the fishing village of Mousehole. We make a photo stop at St Michaels Mount.

DAY TEN

The Luxulyan viaduct is a site to behold and we will stop there on our way to Fowey, Bodinnick and Polperro.

DAY ELEVEN

This morning we visit villages in the Tamar valley, then we stop at Cotehele where we visit house garden and quayside.

DAY TWELVE

Bodmin Moor is nearby. Today we will travel across the moor stopping at two villages on our way to Launceston. Then back to the coast and Boscastle, Port Isaac and Port Gaverne.

DAY THIRTEEN

Today we will travel to Cornwall's south east coast visiting the villages of Helford, Cadgwith and Coverack.

DAY FOURTEEN

We leave Bodmin today and travel to Dunster for the night, stopping at Clovelly, Lynton, Lynmouth, Selworthy and Allerford. Dunster has much to see so make the most of the nights we spend here.

DAY FIFTEEN

Visit Porlock and Porlock Weir this morning and spend the afternoon looking around Dunster.

DAY SIXTEEN

We will visit very beautiful villages on our way to the Cotswolds where we spend the next five nights.

DAY SEVENTEEN

An early start today as we head for abergavenny in Wales, visiting Ross on Wye and Symonds Yat on the way and Ledbury on the homeward journey.

DAY EIGHTEEN

Winchcombe, Bibury, Coln St Dennis and Burford. We will also visit the old Roman village of Chedworth.

DAY NINETEEN

Welford on Avon, Dorsington, Stratford upon Avon and Warwick.

DAY TWENTY

The Swells, The Slaughters, Naunton, Bourton on the Water and Broad Camden.

DAY TWENTY ONE

We travel to Yorkshire visiting Ludlow and Chester on the way.

DAY TWENTY TWO

Swaledale is our destination today, stopping off at Muker, Gunnerside, Langthwaite and over to Askrigg in Wensleydale.

DAY TWENTY THREE

Today is Spring Bank Holiday. We explore Wharfedale, visiting Burnsall, Kettlewell and Grassington.

DAY TWENTY FOUR

Today is market day in Hawes. We shall spend the morning in Wensleydale. The afternoon is free.

DAY TWENTY FIVE

We will venture into Lancashire exploring the Forest of Bowland, visiting villages such as Hornby, Newton, Wigglesworth and back home through Settle and Ribblesdale.
